

For the people who are not on FaceBook, this was posted and is very.... I think the word I want to use is profound. I think we all have been out on the trail at some point and felt what this lady had put in writing.

So you think you know a lot about horses?

You may have made a victory pass at the highest level in your chosen discipline. Jumped a six foot fence or finally got the flying change and strides between the fences. You learned the half passes and maybe "airs above the ground" or halt on the centre line. You might have ridden the rack and slow gait that can win in Freedom Hall. You could be the dare devil on the Three Day Team.

But do you know the history that goes back to 400 BCE when the first art objects show the image of man with the horse? The desert is where the first horse race was recorded in history and those horses were the Arabian. The Bedouins considered them a prize above all other things, including their wives. These horses lived in the tents with their masters because they were key to survival. They went miles in the heat and ran as fast as possible for hours on end.

Imagine that if you can and you will find it today in almost every country in the world. It is the sport of Endurance. It takes understanding more than you ever thought was necessary to even begin to participate. You find yourself in need of the bond you only thought you had with a horse. You become so in tune with their heart beats you feel them in your feet. Your concern with direction becomes important not to get there first but to keep your horse safe.

Time goes by so quickly you have no idea how you covered so much ground but when you get there you are in awe that the horse has carried you there. The responsibility is your own and nobody else's and your knowledge makes it happen. You travel over ground that average people have never seen and you hear a quiet that is only interrupted by the sound of the horse breathing and you understand it like a new language. There is always a moment out there on the trail when you understand life and its true meaning.

So you think you know a lot about horses? I know I did and I was wrong. Endurance changed my life and how I think about horses.

Old Business:

The new Horsemanship Master Score Sheet was provided in 2012

New Business:

- Jennifer reported that the Score Sheets form the Autumn Run LD was incomplete
 - Several contacts were made to Ride Manager (Tammy Beazley)
 - Rider mileage will not be counted until the score sheet has been completed
- Rider Entry Forms are being filled in better this season
- All RM should keep their Entry forms for one year as the signed waver is included
- Jean Bridges is requesting funds for 2013 January Thaw.
 - o Booth \$65, ACTRA link on January Thaw webpage is \$20
 - o \$85 will be allocated
- P&R crews
 - Recommended that a central site be utilized for both LD/ER/CTR
 - Courtesy pulse is not to be mistaken for the Ride Pulse, it is a courtesy pulse only
 - If P&R criteria is not met there MAY be a 2-10 min time penalty
- Meeting Location: general discussion as to weither or not the meeting should be held in a central location
- BOD Positions: 3 positions are up this year. Pres (Kaaren Lebert), Dir at Large (Even Lebert), Sanctioning (Donna Munn)
 - Does the DOB feel that there should be a written description of Duties and Responsibilities
 - Discussed: Felt that these BOD position descriptions are readily available on the web for information purposes.

- Lame Horses: Ride Managers need to encourage ride Vets to ensure that horses are Fit to Continue to receive their completion
- Rider Safety: Riders are to be reminded that they are using public roads and that rules of the Road do apply, and they they are representing our Club and Sport
- Changing of ACTRA name: to be discussed at AGM
- Website: Karen Murray notified Kaaren Lebbert that there has been some problems with access to the ACTRA website, she has not been able to update any site information since September

- P&R

- AGM Location
